Beginning Wire Jewelry

This beginner class will prepare you to make bracelets, earrings, necklaces and more! This simple technique can be adapted to endless projects and is a great way to get experience working with wire. We will make a bracelet in class and discuss other possible projects.



Supplies Required:

22GA round half-hard wire, Sterling or Gold-filled
Beads that will fit on wire
Medium size cabochon
Clasp
