Braided Wire Wrap Bracelet

Learn to plait wire into decorative braid and form into a clasped bangle bracelet using half-round wire. Some experience with wire is necessary to take this class (B/I)



Supplies Required:

22ga dead soft wire, 14 ft (silver, copper, brass, gold filled)

12ga. half round dead soft silver wire, approx. 18"

16ga half round dead soft silver wire, approx. 3'

12ga double half round dead soft wire, approx. 1.5"

Tools Used:

Vise that can attach to table

Round, Chain and Flat nose pliers

Nylon Jawed Pliers

Wire Cutters, flush

Dowel Assortment

Jewelers Saw

2/0 or 3/0 blades

Files

Magnification

Portable Light

A note on cost of supplies -

We prefer not to offer kits for our classes. We try to encourage students to pick equipment and supplies (stones, beads etc.) based on their individual creativity. Often there are several options available and you may have some items already. If you are new to jewelry making, you are welcome to use the shop's tools so you can discover how enjoyable it can be! New students will share the shop tools between them.

Note- this list is designed to help you determine what to bring from home. Not everything is required, and we STRONGLY recommend not buying anything before class if you don't already have it. Many times there are factors that will determine your best choice and we will discuss all this at class. Bring what you have, and don't stress about what you don't.
