Wonky Prong Ring

Continue to improve your soldering skills and learn to set funky, irregular shaped objects with this whimsical silver ring. A great followup to the Silversmithing I class.

Prerequisite: Silversmithing I (I)

Supplies Required:

1x4 silver wire or 2x5 silver wire

18 or 16ga silver wire

Small stone or object to set

Tools Recommended:

Ring mandrel

Nylon or rawhide mallet

Domed head chasing hammer

Jeweler's saw

Blades

Bur lube

Center punch

Chasing hammer

Steel bench block

Nylon jaw pliers

Ring bending pliers

Flat nose pliers

Chain nose pliers

Torch

Quench jar

Cross lock tweezers

Solder pick

#2 half round or ring file

Portable Ott light

3M Polishing papers



A note on cost of supplies -

We prefer not to offer kits for our classes. We try to encourage students to pick equipment and supplies (stones, beads etc.) based on their individual creativity. Often there are several options available and you may have some items already. If this is your first class, you are welcome to use the shop's tools so you can discover how enjoyable it can be! New students will need to share the shop tools between them. **It is important to remember to always bring your tools from home!** Also, please mark them so that they are identifiable as your own.
